Please type or write your narration on a separate sheet of paper, and limit it to between 70 and 100 words (approximately 3 minutes).

**Introduction:** what will the narrator say to welcome you to the stage?

**Outfit Description:** describe your outfit a little bit.

**About You:** Perhaps what you do when you're not doing fashion revue? Hobbies? School? Other 4-H projects?

**Exit:** what will the narrator say when you get ready to leave the stage? Be creative!

Thought Questions for Narrations; Please use these questions to help write narration, DO NOT JUST ANSWER THE QUESTIONS.

1. Why is 4-H important to you?
2. What does the 4-H motto, "To Make the Best Better" mean to you?
3. Why did you select this fabric and pattern?
4. What did you learn while making this outfit?
5. Where are you going to wear this outfit?
6. Do you have any accessories that you will be wearing with your outfit?
7. Why do you participate in 4-H Fashion Revue?

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
