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DEPARTMENT 52 - VISUAL PRESENTATIONS SUPERINTENDENT – COUNTY 4-H OFFICE

SPECIFIC RULES:

1. You may give either a Demonstration/Visual Presentation or Illustrated Talk.
2. They may be given in two categories: Individual or Team.
3. The length should be:
 - a. Clover Division – not more than 5 minutes
 - b. Junior Division – at least 5 minutes but not more than 10 minutes.
 - c. Intermediate & Senior Division – at least 10 but not more than 15 minutes.
4. Illustrated Talk – Is structured with an introduction, body and summary. Instead of actually showing how to do, you explain how by use of illustrations, charts or posters. You usually do this kind of talk in an area where you cannot actually show “how to do something”.
5. Formal Demonstration or Visual Presentation – Is structured with an introduction, body and summary. You are showing step-by-step how to do something resulting in a finished project. You may use posters or charts plus the items you are working with.
6. For a food demonstration, food samples are not to be given to judges. You may offer them a copy of the recipe.
7. Each participant will furnish his or her own equipment and supplies.
8. Each participant is responsible for clearing the area after their talk.
9. Clovers will be evaluated but not judged and will receive a special ribbon.
